NEW BUSINESSES PERMITTED TO REOPEN IN MONO COUNTY

May 30, 2020 – On April 28, the Governor announced four stages of the “Resilience Roadmap” that is guiding the gradual reopening process throughout California and in Mono County. On May 20, California transitioned into Stage 2 to gradually reopen some **lower-risk workplaces with some adaptations**. Additional businesses were permitted to reopen recently including private campgrounds, RV parks, hair salons and barbershops. The following businesses are currently permitted to operate within Mono County, with modifications:

- Private Campgrounds and RV Parks*
- Places of Worship/Religious Services/Cultural Ceremonies
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Professional Guide Services
- Pack Stations
- Marinas
- Dine-in restaurants
- Retail
- Childcare for those outside of the essential workforce
- General Administrative Businesses and Offices (telework remains strongly encouraged)
- Public Transportation
- Select services: car washes, pet grooming and landscape gardening
- Outdoor museums and open gallery spaces and other public spaces with modifications
- Supply chains supporting the above businesses

Every business in Mono County and in the Town of Mammoth Lakes is required to self-report on meeting all applicable County, State and Federal requirements using the SELF-CERTIFICATION PORTAL. **Businesses that satisfy all the health and safety requirements, are required to prominently post the certificate at their place of business.** Additional [Mono County Business Guidance](#) and [Frequently Asked Questions](#) (FAQ) are also available online.
